CRITERIA FOR CONSIDERATION

1. Employment – three years or less in chamber profession as the chief paid executive or member of executive staff.
2. Applicant statement – statement from the applicant explaining reasons for applying, accomplishments in their organization during their tenure, career objectives and future goals for their organization. Self nominations accepted.
3. Supporting documents – examples: articles, letters of support from board, staff & community, personal resume. (One page about involvement in management staff issues, community and leadership abilities, etc.)

3. Total # of membership
4. Membership retention % for past 3 years
